

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: BRIGSTOCK LATHAM'S CE PRIMARY SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is **Brigstock Latham's Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is "**The governing body of Brigstock Latham's Church of England Primary School**"
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. The Headteacher;
  - b. **2** parent governors, to be elected
  - c. **1** staff governor,
  - d. **1** Local Authority governor
  - e. **2** foundation governors;
  - f. **2** co-opted governors.
5. Total number of governors is **9**
6. The Foundation that is entitled to appoint foundation governors is Peterborough Diocese Board of Education.
7. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, which includes respecting other faiths and in partnership with the Church in the parish of Brigstock and at diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its local community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
8. This instrument of government comes into effect on **17 December 2014**
